Rules for students during the test period

1. Students **MUST** sit the test at the **scheduled** time. Written documentation will be required to explain any absence **as per point 12**.
2. Students are **not** permitted to have access to (nor play) i-Pods, i-Phones, i-Pads, MP3 players, CDs or similar devices during any test.
3. Students are **NOT** permitted to use an **electronic** dictionary during any test. Students are permitted to use a language dictionary in non-electronic form.
4. Students **MUST** provide their own **Calculators**; they must be scientific and non-programmable.
5. The Board of Senior Secondary Studies requires that students are to **SUBSTANTIALLY** complete all assessment items. **This means that students need to make a reasonable attempt at answering many questions on the test (showing appropriate working)** – otherwise it is possible they could be considered to have NOT substantially completed the test and receive zero.
6. All tests will be held within the school. Check the test timetable to see where the test is scheduled.
7. Students who arrive late for their test will **NOT** be given an extension of time. Students who arrive later than 15 minutes after the commencement of the test will not be permitted to enter the examination room. Students in this situation should report immediately to the appropriate Director for alternative arrangements.
8. Students are encouraged to **arrive at least five minutes** before the starting time of the test but may not enter the room until directed by the supervising teacher.
9. Students will be required to sit in the area assigned to their class.
10. Students will **not be permitted to leave the test** in the **first quarter** of the allocated test time, **nor the last 10 minute period** of the test.
11. Students are not permitted to talk to, or communicate with, anyone during the test, except a supervising teacher. Students who are found communicating will have their papers annotated and may have a mark penalty imposed. This could include the loss of ALL marks.
12. If, due to unforeseen circumstances, a student has cause to be **absent from a test**:

- **The student must notify the College on that day,**
- Giving details of the unit, the teacher's name and their expected date of return.

Immediately on return

- The student must provide written documentation to Student Admin to explain her/his absence (e.g. a certificate from a registered health practitioner) and
- **May be required to sit for the test.** The mark obtained from this test, along with performance in other assessment items and class work, may be used as a guide in estimating the student's mark for this assessment item.
